Purchasing Bus Ticket

St Paul's School has an agreement with Flexischools which allows students to purchase tickets via their student ID card.

When students board their Private School Bus, they simply swipe their ID card on the terminal which will automatically debit their FlexiSchools account.

Who Can Purchase a Bus Pass?

Passes are available for students in Year 4 to Year 12. Passes may only be purchased for students in Pre Prep to Year 3 if they have an accompanying sibling who is in Year 7 onwards and who travels on the bus with them at all times.

Loss of a Bus Pass:

Should a Student lose their Student ID card, they are to arrange for a replacement which can be reproduced on the day of request. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for the replacement of the Student ID and, this will be automatically billed to the Student Fee Account.

School Responsibilities:

Driver:

- 1. Hold the necessary licence including but not limited to Blue Card, First Aid Certificate, Driver Authorisation, relevant Driver's Licence and qualifications.
- 2. Have knowledge of the Approved Service.
- 3. Be clean and tidy.

Parent/Student Responsibilities:

Students are expected to exercise the highest standard of courtesy and behaviour while on the bus for reasons of safety and well-being of all passengers including the driver:

- 1. Students must remain seated at all times during transit and wear their seat belts. Standing, kneeling, lying down or unnecessary swapping of seats during bus trips is not permitted.
- No objects are to be thrown in or from the bus at any time and littering is not permitted.
- Noise levels from students are always to be of a safe and acceptable level. Shouting is never permitted.
 Students must respect bus property. A student who willfully causes damage will be responsible for the Students must respect bus property. A student who willfully causes damage will be responsible for the cost of repair for the damage they caused.
- 5. Feet and shoes are not permitted on seats at any time.
- 6. No part of a student's body or belongings are to protrude from the window of the bus at anytime.
- 7. No student may call out or signal to any person outside the bus at any time.
- 8. Students must obey any instructions given by the bus driver.
- 9. Footwear and clothing is to be generally clean and tidy before entering bus. Uniform standards are enforceable during bus travel.
- 10. Students will only enter the bus with the driver's permission and in the presence of either the driver or a teacher.
- 11. Food, drinks or chewing gum are not to be consumed at any time (excursions and sport included)
- 12. Bullying or intimidation of another bus user will not be tolerated. Respect for fellow students is to be shown at all times.
- 13. School bags are to be stowed under the seat or in appropriate luggage areas. Aisles must remain free at all
- 14. MP3 Players and i-pods and PC games to be used with earpieces on buses, for personal use only.
- 15. Musical instruments are to be kept in their cases and not to be played during bus trip.
- 16. Students are asked to report any new damage to bus interior to the driver at the end of trip.

Students using the School Bus Service are still bound by the School rules and regulations.

Any student failing to observe the School's Code of Conduct and Behaviour as stipulated in this policy will forfeit the right to use the bus service.

Infringement of any of these rules will result in immediate loss of bus privileges and an obligation to pay restitution for any damages.

Flood Situation Timetable - In the case of a Flood situation the following will occur:

- Morning Run the first two pick up points will be collected 10 mins earlier than stated above, all other stops will remain at their current times.
- Afternoon Run All drop off times will be 10 minutes later except for the first two drop off points which will remain at their current times.

The bus will be equipped with surveillance and bus tracking systems. The School can monitor the bus movements via a GPS tracking system. Should parents require confirmation of bus movements, please contact the St Paul's School Bus Coordinator. Part of the surveillance covers passengers of the bus and bus surroundings upon the bus journey; retention of records is for 3months.
