Q. When do we go?

A. Monday 19 March – Friday 23 March

Q. Can I do my Duke of Edinburgh Award?

A. This camp will qualify you for your Bronze or Silver Award Adventurous Journey. Simply register before we leave and complete your D of E journal while we are away.

Q. What do I eat?

A. All meals, fruit and snacks are provided by the ships cook. They are filling, nutritious and 100% delicious. Second helpings are always available and special dietary needs can be catered for.

Q. What if I am concerned about seasickness? Or have some fears of water and boats?

A. Simply arrange for seasickness medication! The trained watch leaders are fabulous in helping you to manage your time away. The South Passage is a very safe ship and an ideal way to help you to test your boundaries and grow.
