Know Your Venue:

This year, Concert Band Spectacular is again to be run across two venues; The Mary MacKillop Performance Centre, and the St Columban's College Chapel.

Parking:

There are two parking areas available for use over the duration of the Concert Band Spectacular competition. Please refer to the St Columban's College **Parking Map** to identify the best parking for each venue. The main carpark area is via the Pettigrew Street entrance.

On Arrival:

All schools will need to check-in on arrival at the **registration desk** situated at the **Mary MacKillop Performance Centre**. From here you will be directed to your warm-up room to unpack instruments, organize music and warm-up. Ensemble/Band Directors will need to provide two (2) copies of the performance pieces upon arrival at the registration tent.

During Each Performance:

Venue doors are closed during each performance. Please arrive 10-15min early to avoid missing a performance.

Child Supervision:

Child supervision facilities are not available throughout this event. Please do not leave children unsupervised.

Food:

Hot food, snacks, cold drinks and hot beverages will be available for purchase from both the P&F BBQ as well as our Kells Café which will be operating over the two days.

Entry Fee:

Entry fees are payable at the door. CBS Passes are \$5 per day. Free entry will be granted to school-aged children and younger. Cash and EFTPOS facilities will be available for entry fees and refreshments.

Videoring & Photography:

Videoring and photography (including the use of personal mobile devices) are not permitted during performances. This is to ensure we work within copyright legislation and ensure the event's duty of care and child protection. Audio recordings of each ensemble will be made available to each school after the event.

Bus Zone:

The main bus drop-off and pick-up zone is via the Pettigrew Street entrance. This bus zone is for loading and unloading purposes only.
