

School Colours and Blazer Embellishments

Policy

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Criteria for the Awarding of School Colours and Blazer Embellishments - Years 7 to 12

This criterion has been written in accordance with the St Paul's School Ethos Statement.

School Colours and Blazer Embellishments are awarded to recognise participation and excellence in the following areas: *Academic, Sport, Service* and *Cultural*. They are awarded to those students who, through their zeal, participation and example, typify the ideals, ethos and philosophy of the School

General Criteria for the Awarding of School Colours

Recipients of School Colours must demonstrate:

- Excellence in and a strong personal commitment to a range of School activities over a significant period of time
- Excellence in manner and behaviour in accordance with and support for the Ethos Statement of the School
- An active involvement in the life of the School
- Appropriate grooming and presentation
- Reliability
- On at least **Green Level** in Global Citizenship program

School Colours and Blazer Embellishments will be presented on a Combined Assembly or on an Extracurricular Assembly.

Colours and Embellishments Committee

The Colours and Embellishments Committee consists of:

- Executive Director of Faith and Community (Chairperson)
- Director of Curriculum
- Extracurricular Co-ordinator
- Head of Sport Development
- Head of Experiential Learning Development
- Head of Music

The role of this Committee is to verify colour points, consider nominations and recommend to the Headmaster the awarding of Colours and Embellishments, on the basis of students' achievement in Academic, Sporting, Cultural and Service activities.



Headmaster's awards

A Headmaster's Award (Academic) may be presented to a student who achieves Academic Success at a National Level e.g., The Australian Science Olympiads.

A Headmaster's Award (Cultural) may be presented to a student who achieves Cultural Success at a National Level e.g., Selection in the Australian Schools National Debating Team.

A Headmaster's Award (Sport) may be presented to a student who achieves Sporting Success at a National Level e.g., Selection in the Australian Schoolboys Water Polo Team.

A Headmaster's award (Service) may be presented to a students who demonstrates conspicuous service to others, within the School or wider community

Specific criteria for the awarding of School Colours

School Colours are awarded to students in Years 7 to 12 who accumulate points for involvement and / or achievement in any approved extracurricular aspect of School life, as well as for academic excellence or significant service. (See Appendix 'A')

Points are awarded at the end of a Trimester (TAS Sport) or at the end of Term 3 (for All Year Activities). Coaches of Sport or Teachers in Charge of an Activity are responsible for completing a Colours Points List and forwarding it to the Extracurricular Coordinator.

A total of 20 points is required for the award of a School Colour – worn as a full colour pocket (red) on the School Blazer. Students who have not been awarded a School Colour may wear only an outline badge on the School Blazer.

Should a student qualify for the award of a second colour (by accumulating a total of 30 points), a gold laurel wreath may be embroidered around the full colour badge on the pocket.

A Headmaster's Award is presented to any student who accumulates 40 points or more. The award is in the form of an Embellishment on the Blazer Pocket.

A concession is given to students who enter the School after Year 7.

There is no concession for Headmaster's Awards.

One or two points are awarded each year for each extracurricular activity approved by the Headmaster. The points may, however, be withheld if the student is regarded as having been insufficiently responsible in carrying out his/her commitments to the team or club (e.g., not in good standing), or if he/she, has in any way brought discredit to the School (e.g., Orange Level breach of the School's Code of Conduct). To be in 'Good Standing', a team member should attend at least 80% of Training and Matches. Reasons for not attending Training or Matches must be conveyed to the Coach or Teacher in Charge, preferably before the event.

The Committee will make recommendations to the Headmaster, in terms of which Sports and Activities will earn points toward a Colour Pocket, or Awards which may lead to an Embellishment on the Blazer.

Sporting Embellishments are determined by the Colours and Embellishments Committee at the end of each Trimester of Sport. Academic Embellishments are determined by the Committee at the end of Semester 2 (Yr 10 and 11) and Semester 3 (Yr 12). Cultural and other Embellishments are recommended to the Committee by the Head of Music, House Leaders, or Coordinators of Activities as they become known.

Awards are ultimately ratified by the Headmaster.

A record of a student achievement is maintained in TASS and a copy kept by the House Leader.



Blazer Embellishments

- Apart from a Colour Pocket, a student may record on his/her Blazer **particularly meritorious achievements**, once approval has been given by the Headmaster. (See Appendix 'B' and 'C').
- All embellishments are followed by the award/ year of award.

Most Prestigious Award

• In any sport or activity, only two Embellishments for a particular Sport / Activity are permitted in any year eg, If a swimmer is in the Open Girls Team, the Open Girls Team wins the Open Age Group Trophy, the School wins the Aggregate Girls Trophy and then the School wins the overall Co-Ed Trophy, the embellishment would read:

Swimming TAS ** ** 2018

- All three would not be embellished on the blazer. The embellishment *Swimming Open Girls Champions* would be omitted as it is the lesser of the three.
- Note: ** denotes a Mitre symbol which is substituted for a Championship, Premiership, 1st Place, Gold or Platinum Award.

Combining of Awards

• If a student is a member of a Team / Ensemble two years in succession and that Team / Ensemble wins Premierships / Awards in both of those years, only one embellishment is permitted with the addition of the year.

e.g. Cricket 1st XI ** 2018/2018 Wind Ensemble ** 2018/2018

• If a Team or Ensemble wins more than one Premiership / Award in any one year, both are to be included in the one Embellishment.

e.g. Volleyball 1^{st ** **} 2018 Senior Strings ** ** 2018



Multiple Embellishments

TAS rules are quite clear with regards to selection of teams and replacements during a game: No student shall play in more than one team on the same day unless, as a reserve, he/she replaces an injured (or absent) player in a higher age or grade, provided that the maximum playing time of 90 minutes on any one day not be exceeded for Rugby players.

Therefore, no student can be awarded embellishments for two different teams in any one year. Players playing up either as a replacement player for one or more games or as a reserve (bench player) in any number of games, cannot be awarded an embellishment for both teams; that is, if the lower and higher team were Premiers and/or the higher team being the First team in that sport.

e.g. Rugby Yr 10 ** 2018 Rugby 1st XV 2018

Students should only send their blazer for embellishments at the end of a sports season.

Appendix A: School Colour Point Activities

A School Colour Point may be awarded for the following:

- Membership in a School TAS sporting team: (Athletics, Basketball, Cricket, Cross-Country, Hockey, Netball, Rugby, Football, Touch, Swimming, Tennis, Volleyball);
- Membership in a School approved non-TAS sporting team: (Australian Rules Football, Badminton, St Paul's Club Cricket, St Paul's Club Hockey, Fencing, Mountain Biking, and Table Tennis);
- Membership in a School Club or Activity: (Service Learning Committee, Chapel Services, Interact Club, Chess, QDU Debating, Circuit Debating, World School, Amnesty International, Film, Media, Dance, Theatre Sports, Peer Mentors, Drama, School Musicals (includes backstage, band, technical);
- Membership in a School Ensemble: (Bella Vocal Ensemble, Big Band, Chamber Singers, Chamber Strings, Guitar Orchestra, Guitar Ensemble, Jazz Ensemble, Senior Strings, MS Girls Chorale, SS Girls Chorale, St Paul's Chorale, Stage Band, Symphony Orchestra, Vivace Strings, Wind Band, Wind Ensemble)
- School Office Bearers: School Captain, Executive Captain, House Captain, Captain of Middle Schooling
- Outstanding academic achievement: (Dux of Year, Gold Award at C of A)

Activities, which may earn **2 points** include:

- Membership in the following School Ensembles: Worship Music
- Member of the St Paul's School Cadet Unit.
- Mountain Biking

An Extra Colour Point may be awarded for/to:

- Captaining of the School in any of the above TAS sports. e.g. Cricket Captain; Hockey Captain.
- Representing the State or Nation in any of the above TAS sports.
- Presidency or Captaincy of any of the above Clubs or Activities, unless otherwise stated: e.g. Interact President, Dance Captain.
- Captain of Music or Concert Master of any of the above Ensembles. e.g. Jazz Concert Master.
- Cadet Company Commander.

Note:

The following do **<u>NOT</u>** qualify for a Colour Point:

- Event Winners of Swimming and Athletics
- Sports or Cultural Tours
- Service to the School in extracurricular areas, as students will be recognised under the Service Learning Program. Examples: Flag Raiser, Chapel Service, Library Service, Coach or Assistant Coach to a TAS team or a Junior TAS team, Refereeing or Umpiring Home matches for a particular sport, etc.

All embellishments are followed by the mitre (substitute for a Championship, Premiership, 1st Place, Gold or Platinum Award)/ year of appointment (where applicable). Embellishments are only awarded if the Team / Ensemble compete in the Top Level of competition that can be entered.

The following do **NOT** qualify for an Embellishment: However, all awards will be recognised with a Certificate at a Combined Assembly.

- Non TAS Sports.
- Volleyball Qld Volleyball Schools Cup (QVSC) Div 2 Champions or similar.
- AFL Qld Independent Schools AFL Competition (QISAFL) Div 3 Premiers or similar.
- Event Winners in Swimming or Athletics.
- Cultural, Sport or Music Tours.
- B Teams who win a Premiership will be awarded a Trophy/Medallion and a certificate.
- Age Group Champions who will be awarded a Trophy/Medallion and/or Certificate.
- Mountain Biking (with the exception of Mountain Bike Captain).

Notes

When a student receives multiple awards, the Blazer Embellishment must comply with the recommendations in Appendix B – for example:

Example 1.

A student is a member of the Senior Strings Ensemble (a Premier Ensemble). This ensemble also wins a Gold Award at the Brisbane Schools Bands Festival and achieves First Place at the Queensland Music Youth Awards in 2018; therefore the Embellishment is as follows:

Senior Strings ** ** 2018

Example 2.

A student is a member of the Year 12A QDU Debating Team. He/She is also the QDU Debating Captain. This team is also QDU Debating Champions for 2018. The Embellishment is as follows: Debating Captain / Year 12A ** 2018

Example 3.

A student is a member of the 1st XI Cricket Team. He is also the Captain of Cricket and the team wins the 1st XI TAS Premiership in 2018. The Embellishment is as follows:

Cricket Captain / 1st XI ** 2018

Example 4.

A student is a member of the U14 Boys TAS Swimming Team. The Under 14 Boys Team wins the Boys TAS U14 Championship. The Boys Team is also the Boys TAS Aggregate Champions. The School Team is also the Co Ed TAS Champions. The embellishment is as follows:

Swimming U14 ** ** 2018

Example 5.

If there is insufficient room on one line for the Embellishment, then two lines are permitted. For example: A student is a member of the Senior Strings Ensemble (a Premier Ensemble). He / She is also the Strings Concert Master. This ensemble also wins a Gold Award at the Brisbane Schools Bands Festival and achieves First Place at the Queensland Music Youth Awards in 2018; therefore the Embellishment is as follows:

Strings Concert Master 2018 Senior Strings ** ** 2018

Example 6:

Where there are multiple Awards, the most prestigious is used eg, three Gold Academic Awards and Year 10 Dux. The embellishment would be:

Year 10 Dux 2018



Example 7:

If a student is a member of a 1^{st} XI, for example, that wins a Premiership, the student will have one embellishment:

Football 1st X1 ** 2018

Example 8: (If the line does not fit on the pocket, a new line may be used) Where a student gains an embellishment for the same extracurricular activity for two consecutive years, the second year is added to the embellishment (see current criteria) eg,:

1st X1 Cricket 2018/2018 Concert Band 2018/2018

Example 9: (If the line does not fit on the pocket, a new line may be used)

If the student is part of a group that wins a championship in the second, not the first year, the embellishment would be:

1st X1 Cricket 2018/**2018

In all cases, a Certificate is given to the student listing each Award. It is only the Blazer Embellishment which is modified.

The number of embellishments each year is limited to 5 lines ie, a maximum of 30 embellishments in MS/SS) and students are encouraged to plan sensibly if they believe they will receive 5 or more embellishments in a year.
