TAS RETURN To sport



Updated January 27, 2021



TAS has constructed the following plan to assist the Association's return to sport. All restrictions outlined in this return to play update are in conjunction with state and federal governments' recent health advice. These restrictions are valid for both TAS and Junior TAS fixtures and anyone attending these fixtures is required to abide by these guidelines.

NUMBER OF ATTENDEES ALLOWED

With the latest easing of Qld Government restrictions TAS and Junior TAS sport will continue in term 1 of 2021 with no spectator restrictions. However, it is important to be aware that there are still government restrictions in place and for us to maintain compliance with those restrictions, we ask that spectators do not loiter after the game they have come to watch, especially at an indoor venue, where total numbers are limited and additional spectators will impact on our ability to allow families to watch their children play TAS sport.

ARRIVE, PLAY, GO

TAS and Junior TAS matches have not been time managed to allow movement of spectators and players before new matches begin. The current restrictions allow for teams to move onto court while the previous teams are moving off the court. However, to ensure we remain within the relaxed governmental guidelines, it is best if players and spectators arrive for their game, play or watch their game and then move on. This is especially important at our indoor venues where total numbers are limited.

VENUE DIRECTIONS & CHECK IN

Each school has multiple venues in play each week. It is important that you follow the directions of each of our schools as they will all have different ways to manage their compliance with the governmental guidelines. One thing that all schools will have in common is the use of QR code check ins to help us manage our contact tracing. It is extremely important that you check in whenever you arrive at a different school venue.

CANTEEN AVAILABILITY

Canteens will be available at the host school's discretion. All TAS and Junior TAS canteens will be COVID compliant, which in some cases may mean no canteen, or fewer canteen staff, or less variety of food supplies. Please be patient and understand the canteen volunteers are working within the constraints placed upon them.

VENUE RESTRICTIONS

It is a condition of entry that every person attending a
TAS fixture will comply with the protocols the Association has put in place, regardless of the school at which they attend fixtures.
You must follow the instructions of the Biosafety officer/s at all times.

o You must follow the directions of signs and staff of the school at which you visit.

o All attendees must check in via the advertised QR check in code. o If you have recently returned from overseas, feel unwell or display any signs of COVID-19 or reside at home with someone displaying symptoms of COVID-19 you are not to enter a TAS venue.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

We ask that all spectators engage in social distancing while spectating at TAS or Junior TAS events.
