

# WHAT TO DO IN THE EVENT OF A DANGEROUS STORM IMPACTING SCHOOL CHILD COLLECTION

**As Queensland's rainy season becomes more severe, there is a possibility that dangerous storms will make departing the School dangerous for students. In particular, the risk of heavy hail or lightning.**

In the event of a severe storm hitting the School and affecting pick up times at the end of the School day, the following plan will be implemented:

## STEP 1

Students will remain in classrooms until the storm has passed and it is deemed safe for them to leave the School.

## STEP 2

Parents will receive an SMS to their chosen contact numbers on Parent Lounge advising them that students will be unable to leave classrooms until it is deemed safe for them to do so.

## STEP 3

Once the storm is no longer deemed to be dangerous, students will be allowed to leave the classrooms and be collected by their parents or make their way to public transport.

For some students this will mean a more significant disruption due to the unavailability of dedicated School transport services.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenience caused to affected students. Overall our primary goal is to keep all our students as safe as possible.
